

# 2023-24 Women's Summer Matchplay

## TERMS OF THE COMPETITION on The Dunes and The Cups

1. Eligibility: Players with 5 or 7 day Dunes annual playing rights are eligible to contest the Dunes Midweek Summer Matchplay; players with 7 day Dunes annual playing rights are eligible to contest The Dunes 7 Day Member Summer Matchplay. Players with Cups annual playing rights are eligible to contest The Cups Summer Matchplay. The handicap limit for all events is 45. Professionals, honorary or non-financial members, or visitors, are not eligible.
2. The field for each competition will be determined by the closing date or when the limit of players has been reached, whichever is sooner. These players will go into a draw. Any player without an opponent will receive a bye into the next round.
3. Rounds must be played by the stipulated dates on the draws or, in exceptional circumstances, by agreement from the Match Committee. Matches may be played on women's competition days but **must be played either before or at the end of the field. Two matches may be scheduled in the same timeslot should the course require to ease pressure on bookings.**
4. The Match Committee will arrange the date of the final round, which must be played within the stipulated timeframe. It will appoint a referee for the final rounds.
5. Matchplay rounds are to be played from **the red dome placement on the day. Finals will be played off the red plates.**
6. Full strokes are to be given in the Matchplay. **Handicaps on the date of play will apply.**
7. If a match is tied after 18 holes, play will continue until there is a winner.
8. Players may use carts- no medical certificate required.
9. Mobile phones may be used to measure distance, to call for medical assistance or report mechanical failure of equipment only. **Penalty: Loss of hole in match play.**
10. A player's failure to be ready to play off at the agreed tee time will result in loss of hole.
11. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter any of these Terms of the Competition.
