The Dunes Course WOMEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024 TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. A multi day format is being used for the Dunes Course Women's Club Championships as per the dates set out below. 7 Day members must nominate by 21st March, three weeks prior to the start, on which day they wish to play the first 2 rounds. This day cannot be changed. A sign-up sheet will be available in the clubhouse.

The Championships will consist of three x 18-hole stroke rounds. Pin positions will be repositioned in a place of similar difficulty for the Saturday rounds.

Round 1 - Thursday April 11th Round 1 - Saturday April 13th

Round 2 - Thursday April 18th Round 2 - Saturday April 20th

Final Round 3 - All players Saturday April 27th.

- 2. Entry is free and will be automatic if your name is on the booking sheet.
- 3. All women members are entitled to enter the championship subject to having played in six rounds on The Dunes course in club competitions prior to the championship over the last 12 months.
- 4. Members with 5 or 7 Day Dunes Playing Rights are eligible to contest the Dunes championship.
- 5. There is a Gross and a Nett competition. The Gross winner will be the Club Champion. A player is NOT eligible to receive both Gross and Nett trophies. Play will be from the red permanent plates.
- 6. In the event of a tie in the Club Championship (Open Gross Event) there will be a sudden death play-off over two holes (1, & 9 on The Dunes). Ties in the Nett event will be decided by a Countback.
- 7. A referee will be appointed by the Match Committee to attend the play-off.
- 8. For Nett events, a player's handicap on the first day of the Championship will apply for all three rounds.
- 9. Order of play will be in random order in Round 1 and as a seeded draw in Rounds 2 & 3.
- 10. A player who is not on the tee ready to play at the specified time must play at the end of the field.
- 11. Golf Carts may be used for all events. No medical certificate is required.
- 12. No Professionals, honorary or non-financial members, or visitors, are eligible.
- 13. Mobile phones may be used for miScore but switched to silent. They may also be used to call for medical assistance or mechanical failure of equipment. They must not be used to calculate wind speed on the course. **Penalty: 2 strokes**.
- 14. The Women's Match Committee reserves the right to alter any of these Terms of the Competition.
