

THE DUNES GOLF CLUB
WOMEN'S FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024
TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Each Championship comprises 2 x 18-hole stroke rounds to be played off the red permanent markers.
2. Members with 5 or 7 day Dunes playing rights are eligible to contest The Dunes Foursomes Championships. Members with Cups playing rights are eligible to contest The Cups Foursomes Championships.
3. The first stroke round is on 13th June 2024 and the second round on 20th June 2024.
4. Half of the combined daily handicaps on the first day of play will apply to both rounds of the Championships. *(For the daily competitions running concurrently, increased or reduced handicaps for the daily competitions will apply on the second day of play).*
5. Those who tee off the 'odd' tees in round 1, must tee off the 'even' tees in round 2.
6. There will be a gross and nett competition for each Championship. The gross winners on each course will be The Dunes Foursomes Champions and The Cups Foursomes Champions respectively. Players are **NOT** eligible to receive both gross and nett trophies.
7. In the event of a tie in the gross events, there will be a play-off over three holes (1,9,10 on The Dunes; 1,2,3 on The Cups). If players are still tied, there will be a 'sudden death' play-off over the same holes.
8. In the event of a tie in the nett events, there will be a countback as described on Page 15 of The Dunes 2023 Handbook and Syllabus, which is also online.
9. The Women's Match Committee will arrange the time of any play-off. A referee will be appointed by the Match Committee to attend each play-off.
10. Golf carts may be used. No medical certificate is required.
11. No professionals, honorary or **non-financial members**, or visitors, are eligible.
12. Substitutions: Subject to the approval of the Match Committee, following entry into the competition, it is permissible to substitute an alternative player for a nominated player who is unable to compete due to illness, injury or any other justifiable reason. However, such substitutions are only permissible prior to the playing of the first round of the Championships.
13. Mobile phones may be used for miScore but switched to silent. They may also be used to call for medical assistance or mechanical failure of equipment. They must not be used to calculate wind speed on the course. **Penalty: 2 strokes in stroke play**
14. The Women's Match Committee reserves the right to alter any of these terms of the competition.
