

THE DUNES BOWL

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION 2023

1. The event shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the Local Rules of The Dunes Golf Club.
2. It is open to amateur members of Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia (GA).
3. The maximum GA handicap permitted is 35.4 on the day of play. Players must play off their correct handicap and should confirm their GA handicap before registration in order to play off the correct daily handicap.
4. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
5. If a nominated player is unable to compete, another player from the same club may be substituted.
6. In the event of a tie in The Dunes Bowl, the winner shall be determined by a count back combining the three team members' scores over 10-18 holes. If the tie remains it shall be resolved as described on the R&A website under "How Ties will be Decided".
7. A tie in either the Silver or the Bronze award shall be resolved in the same manner.
8. Competitors must be ready to start at their appointed time and arrive in time to register. In the event of an emergency, players may be moved to a later time.
9. A competitor may use a motorised cart at her own expense and should arrange this in advance with The Dunes course management. A medical certificate must be presented on the day if the player is under 65 years of age.
10. An electronic device may be used for miScore and to measure distances only.
11. The Women's Match Committee of The Dunes Golf Club reserves the right to alter any of these conditions as it may deem necessary.
